The Roman Baths

The Roman Baths were built over 2,000 years ago. They are built on a natural hot spring from deep underground. The Romans went to the Baths to wash and swim.



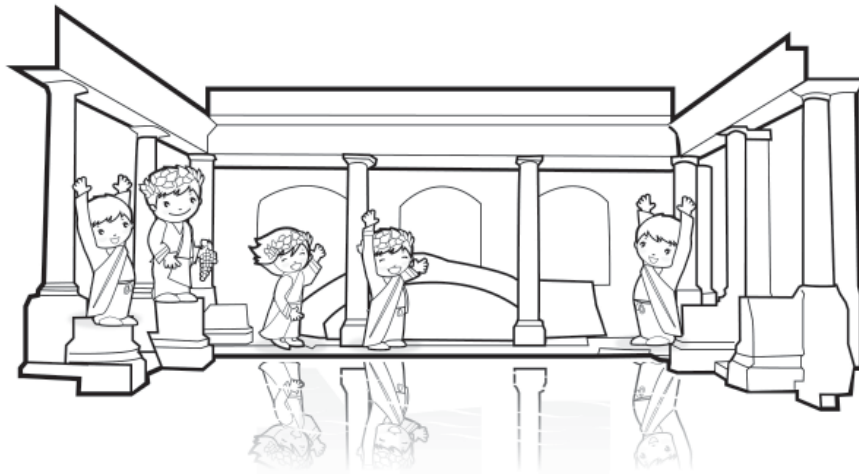
When the spring water hits the Earth's surface, it bubbles as gas escapes - a lot like when you open a bottle of fizzy drink!



As you look onto the Great Bath the water appears green. This is because algae live in it. In Roman times there was a roof over the pool and this would have made the water clear!



A lot of very old objects and statues have been found on the site. People think one is a Gorgon's head. A Gorgon is a monster that turns people to stone!
